- A Major scale and arpeggio - 1 octave
- D Major scale and arpeggio - 1 octave
- E Minor scale and arpeggio - 1 octave
- G Major scale and arpeggio - 2 octaves

The resources will help you to:

- be reminded of the type of sound you are aiming for.
- remember which rhythm to use.
- practice slurs.
- check your tuning against a key note.
- think about patterns that occur within the notes of scales and arpeggios as well as the ones that you can feel when using your fingers on the strings.
- work aurally and kinesthetically. Follow the information in the glossary and work visually as well.
