

Grade 3 Associated Board violin examination scales and arpeggios

Resources and videos created to help my pupils with the scale and arpeggio requirements for Grade 3. There is also a glossary of time saving and motivational tips and a practice record to enable them keep track of what they are doing. Only my pupils can access this course.

E Major scale and arpeggio - 1 octave
E flat Major scale and arpeggio - 1 octave
D Major scale and arpeggio - 2 octaves
D Minor scale and arpeggio - 2 octaves
D Chromatic - 1 octave
B flat Major scale and arpeggio - 2 octaves
A Minor scale and arpeggio - 2 octaves
A flat Major scale and arpeggio - 1 octave

The resources will help you to:

- have an idea in your head of the sound you are aiming for.
- remember which rhythm to use.
- practice slurs.
- check your tuning against a key note.
- think about patterns that occur within the notes of scales and arpeggios as well as the ones that you can feel when using your fingers on the strings.
- work aurally and kinesthetically. Follow the information in the glossary and work visually as well.
- be aware of some of the theory behind these examination requirements.
