


Folk Fiddle lessons / Group Sight reading / Violins and Violas /

The music for the Aberdeenshire Volunteers by James Scott Skinner.

Key: D Major

Time signature: 4/4

Rhythms: The 1st part contains the following elements:

 and quaver upbeats.

The 2nd and 3rd parts have  with quaver upbeats.

Level of ability: There are three parts:

- i) The tunes chosen require a good working knowledge of the keys with any finger pattern 1_23 or 12_3 or 1_2_3 involved. They are available both for violin and for viola (usually an 8ve lower).
- ii) 2nd Violin/Viola treble clef uses basic rhythms in the 1_23 pattern.
- iii) 3rd Violin/Viola treble clef consists of open strings and a couple of 1st fingers and has been designed to be suitable for violin pupils who have just completed a year of Wider Opportunities or are sight-reading in an orchestra for the first time. The viola part is suitable for viola players starting to read treble clef.
- iv) There is a chord part for piano

There are three different speeds of teaching material available and a range of straightforward rhythms have been used to encourage the reading of whole bars at a time.
